The Community is a Parisian multidisciplinary art institution established in 2016. It was founded for a long-standing need for shared space and a platform to stimulate ideas and create collaboration across cultures and different artistic disciplines. In 2021, The Community opened its new location in the northeast part of Paris, in Pantin, consisting of more than 500m² of space and an outdoor garden. Exploring the notion of the new institution, The Community Centre plays host to and explores the shifting intersections between cultural and social activities. Imagined as an alternative to institutional models, The Community Centre is dedicated to cultural and interdisciplinary programming. The programmed space features frequently changing projects – exhibitions, events, concerts, performances, conferences, and talks – across various disciplines, from art to fashion to music to publishing. The Community has inaugurated a new public programming, focusing on free workshops and initiatives for local kids, and teenagers. Together with public bodies, associations, and pedagogical institutions, the goal is to develop an open and welcoming dialogue locally around arts and culture.
